

## What is the Youth School?

The Youth School is a special Danish education form, where youth can study in their spare time, and is one of many leisure time offers for youth from 8<sup>th</sup> grade in Hvidovre Kommune. For some of the courses the Youth School can also take in youth from 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade. These courses are marked with a \*.

The pupil will always receive a letter informing about time and place for the chosen course. The education season counts approximately 23 weeks. We do not have courses during school holidays.

We can only start courses

- when the economy allows it
- enough pupils sign up for a course

Pupils receive free education and materials in most courses. For expensive courses – travelling or different weekend arrangements - there will be a fee.

It is possible to pass an exam for 9. or 10. graders on some more specified courses. It is also possible to participate on an exam related course and not take the degree.

The pupil can receive a Youth School Diploma after a fully ended course. This diploma is documentation for participation and describes the content of the course.

The Youth School has no insurance and therefore do not cover for the loss of private articles of pupils, even if these might have been in a locker.
